**EMPLOYMENT AND INDUSTRIAL RELATIONS ACT
(CAP. 452)
Adaptation of Laws
(Wages Council Wage Regulation Orders) Order, 2016**

IN exercise of the powers conferred by articles 4 and 48(2) of the Employment and Industrial Relations Act, the Prime Minister and the Minister for Social Dialogue, Consumer Affairs and Civil Liberties have made the following order -

Citation and coming into force.

1. (1) The title of this Order is the Adaptation of Laws (Wages Council Wage Regulation Orders) Order, 2016.

(2) This Order shall come into force on the 1st January, 2016.

Amendments to the Wages Council Wage Regulation Orders.

2. The words and phrases referred to in the third column of the Schedule I to this Order, which words and phrases occur in the provisions specified in the second column of the said Schedule, which provisions are to be found in the enactments referred to in the first column of the said Schedule, shall be amended in accordance with the amendments referred to in the fourth column of the said Schedule.

Amendments to Annexes and Tables of the Wages Council Wage Regulation Orders.

3. The provisions relating to Annexes, Tables and Forms which provisions are referred to in Schedule II to this Order, shall be amended in accordance with the amendments referred to in the said Schedule.
