Employment of Persons with Disability - Meeting with the Prime Minister

On Friday 15th January, MEA representatives met the Prime Minister, in the presence of Minister Evarist Bartolo and Mr. Clyde Caruana, Chairman of ETC to discuss a way out of the current impasse concerning the imposition of quotas and fines on companies related to the employment of persons with disability.

The meeting was positive and important progress was registered. The MEA is now working on a revised Memorandum of Understanding to be signed with ETC. There are still a few pending issues which will be cleared directly with ETC.

We thank our members for their strong support and promise our full commitment to obtain the best outcome possible which should work in the interest of all stakeholders. We are also pleased to note that a number of companies have managed to resolve their issues with ETC which is partly the result of these discussions. As soon as the MOU is finalised we will lift the directive.
